

Consensus Design for Tourism Facilities Designing Case Study: The Knitting Kampong Binong Jati, Bandung

ABSTRACT

This research present a consensus design for the tourism facilities design in one of the creative industry areas, the Bandung Knitting Kampong Binong Jati. The area Knitting Kampong Binong Jati has been established as a shopping tourism area by the Bandung government, but unfortunately the Knitting Kampong Binong Jati could not respond quickly to the plan. The process of consensus design by Christopher Day is applied in the design method of tourism facilities of the area. This method ensures the involvement and participation of Binong Jati citizens, so that the aspirations of the Binong Jati community is represented.

Nineteen participants, who are knitters, members of society, and members of community organizations in the Kampong, follow the design of tourism facilities in the Knitting Kampong Binong Jati. The consensus is carried out five times, and each consensus lasted two hours. The first consensus proposed the root of the problems that related to social and economic issues. The second consensus identified the root of the problem and re-formulated its strategy. The third consensus generated program space, which consists in a communal, commercial, supporting tourism, education and parking facilities. The fourth consensus produced building criteria, generated analysis of function activities and building mass. The fifth consensus resulted in circulation, open space and vegetation analysis.

Based on the consensus process, the major design concept of the tourism facilities of Knitting Kampong Binong Jati is “Knitting Park”, which is a mixed-use building with open space and a garden. Through this design concept, this building can be a park for the citizens of the Knitting Kampong and can also be expected to solve the social and economic problem in the area.
